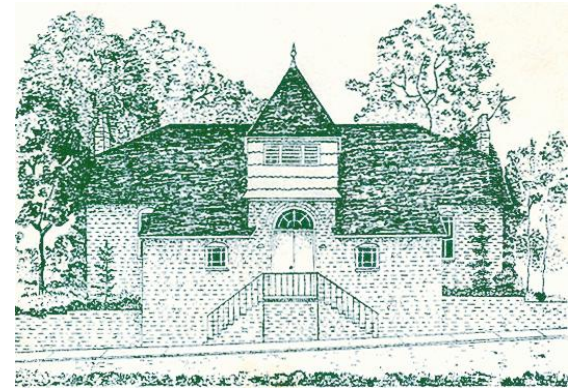

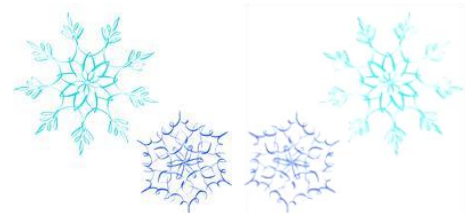


Inclement Weather Policy

Project Linus

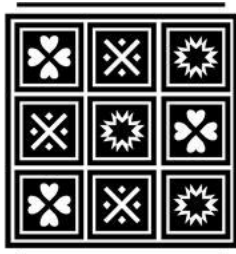
