The Carroll County Government wants to help you **recycle**. On Saturday, June 19, 2010, from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. at the Carroll County Vehicle Maintenance Facility at 1250 Old Meadow Branch Road, Westminster (off Rt. 97), they will accept: **COMPUTER EQUIPMENT** (computers & monitors, laptops, keyboards, printers, mice, hard drives, tape & zip drives, etc.); **COMSUMER ELECTRONICS** (DVD players, VCRs, gaming devices, stereo components (no speakers), radios, PDAs, cables, etc.); **TELEVISIONS** (CRTs/LCDs, no consoles); and **OFFICE EQUIPMENT** (telephones, fax machines, copiers, etc.).

They will *not accept*: **HOUSEHOLD APPLIANCES** (hair dryers, irons, curling irons, vacuum cleaners, etc.); kitchen appliances (blenders, toaster ovens, coffee makers, microwavers, etc.); and **LARGE APPLIANCES** (refrigerators, freezers, ovens, stoves, dishwashers, air conditioners, water heaters, etc.).

Residential Household Hazardous Waste Drop Off Event - **ACCEPTABLE**: Gasoline or Gas/oil Mix, Oil Base Paints & Thinners, Solvents, Stains, Sealants, Pesticides, Herbicides, Photographic Chemicals, Pool Chemicals, Insecticides, Household Cleaners, Compact Fluorescent Bulbs, and Fluorescent Tubes.




Not Acceptable: Latex Paint, Explosives/Ammunition, Medical Waste, Radioactive Material, Compressed Gas Tanks & Cylinders, Rechargeable Batteries, Vehicle Batteries, Asbestos, and Business (commercial, industrial, farm).

Shred It! Document Management: Invoices, Bank Statements, Personal Records, Leases, Time Cards, Balance Sheets, Audit Reports, Blueprints, Credit Reports, Drug Screens, X-Rays, & Back-up Disks (three box or bag limit).
